(hereinafter referred to as the “**Company**”), having its offices at 301, Spaces 912, Mira Bhayandar Road, Pleasant Park Signal, Mira Road East Thane (West), Maharashtra, India, where such expression shall, unless repugnant to the context thereof, be deemed to include our respective legal heirs, representatives, administrators, permitted successors and assigns are the creators of this Privacy Policy, which ensures our steady commitment to Your privacy with regard to the protection of your invaluable information. This privacy policy contains information about a SaaS platform called ‘Tallery Gallery’ (hereinafter referred to as the “**Platform**”). In order to provide you with uninterrupted use of our services, we may collect and, in some circumstances, disclose information about you. To ensure better protection of your privacy, we provide this notice explaining our information collection and disclosure policies, and the choices you make about the way your information is collected and used.

1. DEFINITIONS

- i. The term **'You' &'User'**, shall mean any legal person or entity accessing or using the services provided on this Platform, who is competent to enter into binding contracts, as per the provisions of the Indian Contract Act, 1872.
- ii. The terms **'we'**, **'us'**, **'our'** shall mean the Platform and/or the Company, as the context so requires.
- iii. The term **'Services'** shall mean the SaaS platform that is run by the Company under the name 'Tallery Gallery' that is for bloggers, web designers, publishers, visualisers, branding agencies and presentation creators who need images for their professional requirements.
- iv. The terms **'Party'** and **'Parties'** shall respectively be used to refer to the User and the Company individually and collectively, as the context so requires.
- v. "Personal Information" shall mean and refer to any personally identifiable information that We may collect from You. For removal of any doubts, please refer to Clause 2.
- vi. "Third Parties" refer to any Platform, company or individual apart from the Users and the creator of this Platform.

2. INFORMATION COLLECTED

We are committed to respecting your online privacy. We further recognize your need for appropriate protection and management of any Personal Information You share with us. Since we provide certain services as mentioned above, we may collect the following information which are appropriately required to provide such services:

From Users, information including name, contact number, email address, etc. as mentioned in the Terms of Service is collected. We collect, and store personal information provided by you from time to time on the Platform. We only collect and use such information from you that we consider necessary for achieving a seamless, efficient and safe experience, customized to your needs including:

- a. To enable the provision of services opted for by you;
- b. To communicate necessary account and service related information from time to time;
- c. To allow you to receive quality customer care services;
- d. To comply with applicable laws, rules and regulations

Where any service requested by you involves a third party, such information as is reasonably necessary by the Company to carry out your service request may be shared with such third party.

We also do use your contact information to send you offers based on your interests and prior activity. The Company may also use contact information internally to direct its efforts for service improvement but shall immediately delete all such information when you have decided not to use Tallery Gallery and its services. We collect and store your search details on the Platform, including your search history, the usage of the Platform and the features and time you have used the Platform for. We collect any communications between you and other Users//third-parties on the Platform.

Transacting over the internet has inherent risks which can only be avoided by you following security practices yourself, such as not revealing account/login related information to any other person and informing our customer care team about any suspicious activity or where your account has/may have been compromised.

At every stage prior to, during or after information collection, you have the right to access all personally identifiable information provided, rectify or alter all personally identifiable information provided, restrict the level of information to be retained as per your sole discretion and object to the retention, use and potential disclosure of the personally identifiable information.

Users are responsible for maintaining the security and confidentiality of their account details and passwords. Please note that We will never ask you for your password in an unsolicited phone call or in an unsolicited e-mail. Further, Users are advised to sign off from their systems after availing of the Services to avoid accidental and unauthorized access to personal information from their accounts by any third-party.

3. USE OF INFORMATION

The Platform shall collect information, as mentioned hereinabove, about the Users for the purpose of providing customized Services. The Platform shall intimate the Users as to the purpose of collection of information, if the same changes at any time, and the User shall be

permitted to withdraw consent to provide such information if the User does not agree with the purpose for which the information is being collected by the Platform.

4. RECORD ACCESS AND CONTROL: RESPONSIBILITY

The Platform shall contain the User's records. The User, upon consent, shall be provided with access to the records at any time, and the User may be allowed to withdraw their consent for the retaining of their records by the Platform.

5. OUR USE OF YOUR INFORMATION

The information provided by you at the time of registration and thereafter shall be used to contact you when necessary. For more details about the nature of such communications, please refer to our Terms of Service. Further, your personal data may be collected and stored by us for internal record.

We use your tracking information such as IP addresses, and or Device ID to help identify you and to gather broad demographic information. 6. COOKIES

We use data collection devices such as "cookies" on certain pages of our Platforms. "Cookies" are small files sited on your hard drive that assist us in providing customized services. We also offer certain features that are only available through the use of a "cookie". Cookies can also help us provide information, which is targeted to your interests. Cookies may be used to identify logged in or registered users. Our Platform uses session cookies to ensure that you have a good experience. These cookies contain a unique number, your 'session ID', which allows our server to recognize your computer and 'remember' what you've done on the site. The benefits of this are:

- b. Our server can distinguish between your computer and other users, so you can see the information that you have requested.

We also use various third-party cookies for usage, behavioral, analytics and preferences data. The following are the different types of Cookies used on the Platform:

- a. **Authentication cookies:** To identify the user and share the content that he or she requested for.
- b. **Functionality cookies:** For customized user experience and resuming past course progress.
- c. **Tracking, optimization and targeting cookies:** To capture usage metric on device, operating system, browser etc. To capture behavioral metrics for better content delivery. To cater and suggest most suited products and services.

We however store non sensitive data such as last 4 digits of credit card, expiration date, account holder name and account's billing address. If you have any query please write to us at support@tallery.gallery.

10. YOUR RIGHTS REGARDING INFORMATION

Unless subject to an exemption, you have the following rights with respect to your personal data we hold:

- a. The right to request a copy of your personal data which we hold about you;
- b. The right to request for any correction to any personal data if it is found to be inaccurate or out of date;
- c. The right to withdraw Your consent to the processing at any time;
- d. The right to object to the processing of personal data;
- e. The right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority
- f. The right to obtain information as to whether personal data are transferred to a third country or to an international organization.

11. CONFIDENTIALITY

Your information is regarded as confidential and therefore shall not be divulged to any third party, unless if legally required to do so to the appropriate authorities, or if necessary to ensure Users may fully avail of the services of the Platform.
